

**PARADIGM TABLES FOR KAZYM KHANTY**

3. Verbal nouns

3.1. Infinitive *-ti*

Stem	INF
<i>ma-</i> give	<i>ma -ti</i> give -INF 'give'
<i>man-</i> go	<i>man -ti</i> go -INF 'go'

3.1.1. Stem ending in a consonant cluster:

Stem	INF
<i>seŋk-</i> beat	<i>seŋk -ti</i> beat -INF 'beat'
<i>jaŋx-</i> go	<i>jaŋx -ti</i> go -INF 'go'

3.1.2. Stem ending in *-nʃ* or *-nʃsʲ*:

Stem	INF
<i>xanʃ</i> write	<i>xanʃ -i</i> write -INF 'write'
<i>janʃsʲ-</i> drink	<i>janʃsʲ -i</i> drink -INF 'drink'

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3.1.3. Stem ending in -ʃ or -sʃ:

Stem	INF
<i>βəʃ</i> lose oneself	<i>βəʃ</i> - <i>i</i> lose oneself      -INF 'lose oneself'
<i>xasʃ</i> stay	<i>xatç</i> - <i>i</i> stay      -INF 'stay'

3.2. Present Participle *-ti*

Please note: active and passive function

Active: *jaŋŋə-ti jəx* 'walker'

*tuŋət-ti ne* 'reading woman'

Passive: *janʃi jɪŋk* 'drinking water'

3.3. Past Participle *-əm*

Please note: active and passive function

3.3.1. Stem ending in vowel:

Stem	PTCP.PST
<i>βu-</i> take	<i>βu</i> - <i>jəm</i> take      -PTCP.PST 'taken'
<i>ma-</i> give	<i>mi</i> - <i>jəm</i> give      -PTCP.PST 'given'
<i>ji-</i> come	<i>ju</i> - <i>βəm</i> come      -PTCP.PST 'come'

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<i>tə-</i> fetch	<i>tu -βəm</i> fetch -PTCP.PST 'fetched'
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3.3.2. Syncopatic stem:

Stem	PTCP.PRS
<i>ʃuŋət-</i> read	<i>ʃuŋt -əm kn'iga</i> read -PTCP.PRS book 'the read book'
<i>joxət-</i> come	<i>tiβ joxt -əm ik -et (xə -jət)</i> here come -PTCP.PRS man -PL (man -PL) 'the men who came here'

3.4. Gerund *-man*

Stem	CVB
<i>ńax-</i> laugh	<i>ńax -man</i> laugh -CVB 'laughing'
<i>ʃuŋət-</i> read	<i>ʃuβ ʃuŋət -man ɔ:məs -ət</i> he read -CVB sit -PRS[3SG] 'he sits reading'
